**MEDfx Practice Management Solution ---
GBA Offers Linux-based ASP Model**

Warwick, RI – June 26, 2006 – GBA Health Network Systems today announced the release of a Linux-based Application Service Provider (ASP) offering of its highly successful web-based MEDfx Practice Management solution.

They can access the software from their workstations while the server is miles away in a data center where security is monitored and information is protected 24/7. The practice sees a drastic cost reduction when MEDfx becomes a predictable, monthly line item expense.”

Launched just over two years ago, MEDfx features Java Enterprise Edition architecture with a rich client browser-based interface. Built to HIPAA regulations, MEDfx was designed to meet these transaction and security requirements from the onset.

In short, said Mr. Barry, “MEDfx and Linux are bringing a technology to healthcare that has already transformed nearly every other major industry in this country.”
